Member is white, non-Hispanic female who is 5'5" tall and weighs 175lbs. She lives in a house, alone with her animals and said she is safe there. Member reports 3 SAB's near 4wga in 2002, 2003 and 2007. She denies any recent hospitalizations and 1 ER visit due to sub chorionic hemorrhage 5/2021. Surgeries; tooth pulled, D and C 2003, left rotator cuff surgery 2009 and neck/clavicle/scapula reconstructing 2007 she now has a titanium left shoulder. Member is not employed, does not exercise, has a college degree and denies any past or present drug, alcohol or tobacco use. She is on the WIC program and gets food stamps \$200/mo she would like more money to help get more food. She plans to breast feed, discussed that SHP can provide her with a pump, she verbalized understanding. She has reliable transportation, said her phone is getting cancelled and SHP is getting her one. Member said her father lives in a different state, said he can be "verbally abusive" at times and used to help her financially but he has blocked members calls, she thinks it's because she will not get the covid vaccine. Members mother was killed by a drunk driver when she was out Christmas shopping when member was 16yrs old, they lived in a different state at this time. Member said the Christmas holiday is hard for her. Member has her church ladies come help with chores. G4PO, EDD 01/10/2022, estimated 28.3wga. Member said this was unplanned, she was told she could not have kids. Father of baby is "kind of supportive" . Member said he does not have custody of his other child, "drinks" and "was recently in jail". Member is on WIC, food stamps and the LIEAP program.

Preeclampsa, liver enzyme problem and pre DGM dx 8/2021. She has been on bed rest since 5/21/21 with a 5lb weight limit in pregnancy, 25lb weight limit for life outside of pregnancy.
