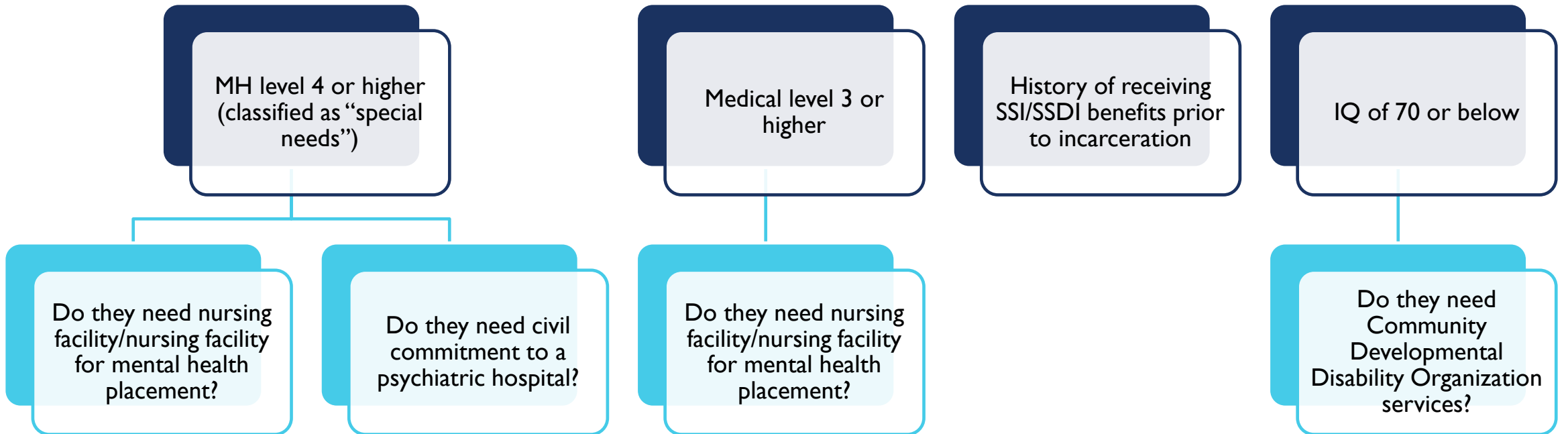
DISCHARGE PLANNING BASICS

DISCHARGE PLANNING CRITERIA





Resident

Does resident meet disability criteria?

Provide with Community Resources

**Verify SSI/SSDI Status
Complete PMDT (if no SSI/SSDI)
Complete Medicaid and send both to CO 90 days pre-release**

Resident Needs Nursing Home

Resident Needs HCBS Waiver Services

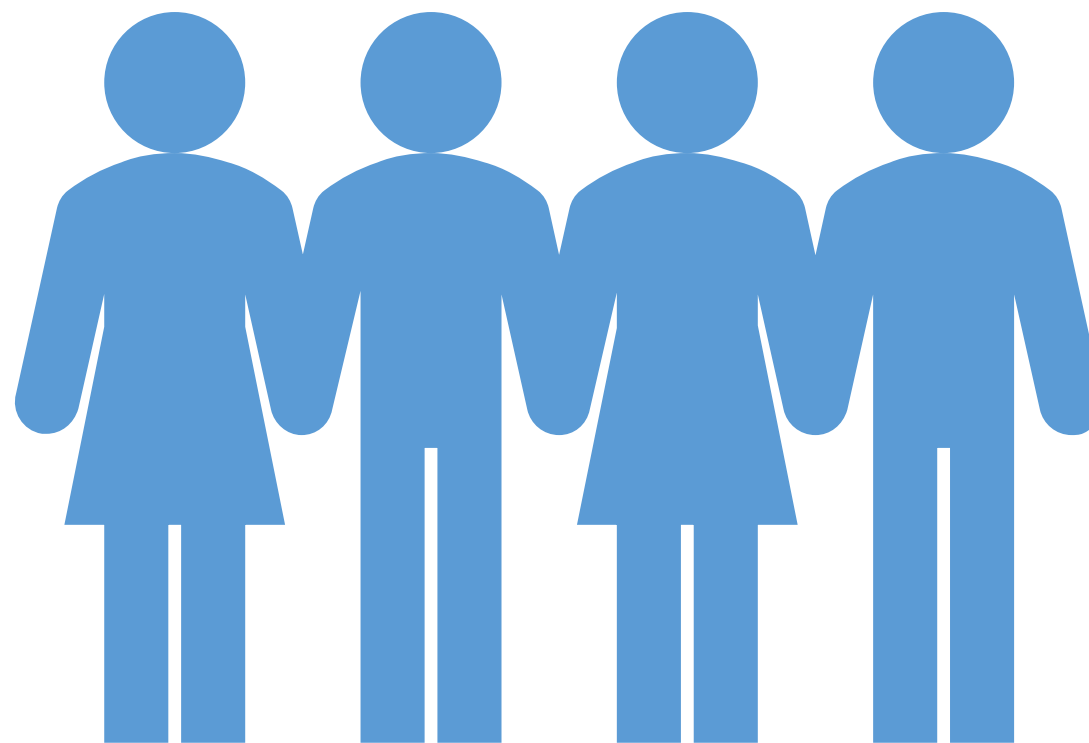
Resident Needs Civil Commit
